**General Procedures**

The Board will take up to 15 minutes at the beginning of the meeting and if needed, additional public comment will be taken at the end of the meeting on items not listed on the Hearing Agenda.

WHEREAS, it has been demonstrated to the Liquor Licensing Authority for the County of Jefferson, State of Colorado, that probable cause exists that you have violated the Colorado Liquor Code and the Rules and Regulations for the Liquor Enforcement Division, Department of Revenue, State of Colorado, governing your license in the following particulars:

1. C.R.S. §44-3-901(1)(b)(I) provides in relevant part: Except as provided in sections 18-13-122, it is unlawful for any person to sell, serve, give away, dispose of, exchange, or pert the sale, serving, giving, procuring of any alcohol beverage to or for any person under the age of twenty-one years.
2. On June 2, 2022, Investigators James Taylor and Mario Gonzalez conducted a liquor license compliance operation in Jefferson County, Colorado. An underage under cover agent of the Sheriff's Office, herein , herein after referred to as UC, was used to enter stand-alone, off-

premise liquor licensed establishments in Jefferson County in an attempt to purchase alcoholic beverages. The UC went into the establishment with \$20 cash and no identification. If asked for identification, the UC was instructed to tell the individual asking that he/she forgot his/her ID. If asked for his/her birthdate, he/she was to provide true birthdate, which would indicate the UC is under twenty-one years of age.

3. Investigators Taylor and Gonzalez and the UC arrived at 82 Liquor, located at 10143 West Chatfield Avenue #5, Littleton, CO 80127 at approximately 2:00 p.m.. on June 2, 2022. The UC went into the store while the investigators remained outside.

4. The UC exited the store with a six pack of Breckenridge Brewery Avalanche Ale, and the change from the \$20 bill used to purchase the beer. The UC indicated he/she was asked for identification when purchasing the beer but advised that he/she did not have identification. The transaction was completed anyhow.

5. Investigators Taylor and Gonzalez then entered the store and contacted Taiping Wen, who was working behind the counter and is also an owner of the store. Ms. Wen confirmed that she sold alcohol to the UC but denied that the UC was underage. Investigator Taylor returned the alcohol and the change to Ms. Wen. The UC confirmed that Ms. Wen sold him/her the alcohol.

6. 82 Liquors has no previous violations under current ownership.

NOW THEREFORE, you are hereby ordered to appear before this Authority at the Jefferson County Courts and Administration Building, 100 Jefferson County Parkway, Golden, Colorado on **October 6, 2022**, commencing at **9:00 a.m.**, or as soon thereafter as you can be heard, to SHOW CAUSE why your license should not be suspended or revoked as provided by law. The hearing will occur in Hearing Room One, First Floor of the Administration Building.

You are entitled to have an attorney represent you at the hearing. If you fail to appear at the aforementioned hearing, testimony will still be taken regarding the allegations noted above, upon which evidence your license to operate under the terms of the Colorado Liquor Code may be suspended or revoked and other adverse action taken against your license. If you appear at the hearing, you will be given a reasonable opportunity to cross-examine prosecution witnesses and to tender evidence.

Be further advised that if this authority does find you in violation of any of the above- cited section(s) of the Colorado Liquor or Beer Code, it may then consider in selecting the sanctions to be imposed against you, all prior violations of the Liquor or Beer Code by you as well as any sanctions previously imposed against you.

Be further advised that if you have a retail liquor store or liquor-licensed drug store license and have or are applying for a "tasting permit", the Jefferson County Rules and Regulations relative to a tasting permit, state as follows "Section I (2) ..."If an

application for a "tasting permit" has been granted and the licensee's license is subsequently suspended or revoked, or has any suspensions held in abeyance or stayed by payment of a fine in lieu, the application and any scheduled tasting dates shall be canceled until such time as the Liquor Licensing Authority approves a new application."

**NOTICE:** Requests to postpone the hearing and proposals to resolve the issues Contained herein WILL NOT be considered by the Jefferson County Liquor Licensing Authority unless such requests or stipulations are filed, in writing with the Clerk to the Board of County Commissioners **SEVEN (7)** days in advance of the scheduled hearing.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a copy of this Order and Notice shall be mailed or personally delivered to the above-mentioned Licensee.
