Notes:

- (1) Approved as part of regional call for projects
- (2) Westminster to request \$1.5M from Adams County Subregional allotment
- (3) Additional contribution requested to cover shortfall from denial of Adams and Denver County subregion requests during regional call

- Each project was scored on a scale of 1 to 3 in several categories and these scores were weighted and averaged to determine an overall score. Scoring was done by staff from each of the member local jurisdictions, CDOT, and DRCOG.
- The scored list of projects was reviewed by the Forum’s technical committee resulting in this prioritized project list.
- 32nd Avenue Bike Lanes will be waitlisted so all the other projects on the Forum’s list can be funded. A waitlisted project may receive funding in the future if additional funding becomes available.
- The Adams County Subregion (ADCOG) recommended federal funding in the amounts of \$500K to the Peaks-to-Plains trail and \$1.5M to the US 36th project.
- The projects on this list is the recommendation from the staff.
- The Forum accepted this list with no objections as a recommendation to the DRCOG Board of Directors.
