Background

The TCWDB consists of decision-making individuals reflective of the business demographics in the region and leaders from the workforce system, education, labor, and economic development. It focuses on determining the near- and long-term needs of employers by providing oversight of a multi-million dollar workforce budget. The TCWDB meets approximately 10 times per year for 90 minutes on the first Tuesday of the month.

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New Business Member Requirements

- The applicant must have optimum policy making or hiring authority within the company, such as the HR Manager, CEO, or Director.
- The organization must provide employment opportunities for in-demand sectors or occupations in the region and provide high-quality training and development opportunities to its workforce.
- Small businesses are encouraged to apply.

Application

The application process (which takes 4-6 weeks) requires appointment of new Board members by the Jefferson County Board of County Commissioners.
