The following Wildlife, Vegetation and Landscaping report is being submitted as required by Section 4 B. 31 of the Jefferson County Land Development Regulations.

- Since this development is existing, there will be no change in wildlife or vegetation habitats.
- Due to the very small size of this subdivision, minimal impacts to the wildlife and vegetation habitats are anticipated. Existing wildlife and vegetation habitats are as follows:

- This subdivision has the characteristics suitable to support the habitat of the Preble's jumping mouse, a vary rare mouse that is listed as threatened by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service under the Endangered Species Act. Preble's mice typically inhabit areas characterized by well-developed plains with riparian vegetation with relatively undisturbed grassland and a water source in close proximity.
