Cheatgrass	
<b>General</b>	Family: Grass (Poaceae) Introduced from Europe Colorado List C - Control recommended
<b>Common names</b>	Downy brome
<b>Habitat</b>	Annual to winter annual Found in rangelands, pastures, open areas, roadsides and disturbed areas One of the first grasses to emerge in early spring Dries quickly and can be a fire hazard
PLANT	
<b>Vegetation</b>	Mature plants up to 2 feet tall Leaves about 1/8 inch wide and up to 8 inches long Covered with soft hairs Turns red late in season
<b>Roots</b>	Fibrous Up to 12 inches deep
<b>Flower</b>	May-June Nodding panicles to 8 inches long
<b>Seed</b>	Germinates in fall through early spring Attaches easily to shoes and clothing
<b>Seedling</b>	Bright green
<b>Reproduction</b>	Seed

<b>CHEMICAL</b>	<i>Stage</i>	<i>Herbicide</i>	<i>Timing</i>
	Seedling	Imazapic (Plateau) Rimsulfuron (Matrix)	Fall
	Seedling to early growth stage	Glyphosate (Many) Imazapic + glyphosate (Journey)	Late winter when all other plants are dormant. Usually prior to March 15 <sup>th</sup>
<b>CULTURAL</b>	Prevention Fertilization to promote grass cover Revegetation of highly disturbed sites Removal		
<b>MECHANICAL</b>	<i>Stage</i>	<i>Method</i>	<i>Timing</i>
<b>Burning</b>	Prior to seed development	Cheatgrass burns readily but follow-up herbicide treatment and revegetation is needed. <i><u>Cheatgrass can create a heightened fire risk.</u></i> <i>Consult your local fire department for burning requirements and restrictions</i>	Late winter - Early spring
<b>Grazing</b>	Prior to boot stage & then again 3-4 weeks later	Focused intense grazing. Animals will not graze once the seedheads develop	Late winter - Early spring
<b>Mowing</b>	N/A	Not effective. Plants will regrow and still set seed
