

Your Pet & Coyotes

All Front Range communities are home to coyotes. These clever canids have readily adapted to our food and habitat-rich environments. Colorado Parks & Wildlife wants to help you avoid conflicts with coyotes in your neighborhood.

- **Keep pets on a leash when walking.**
- **Never allow your pets to “play” with a coyote.**
- **Pick up small pets if confronted by a coyote.**
- **Do what you can to discourage a coyote’s approach — yell, stomp your feet, throw small rocks or sticks at it.**
- **Always supervise your pet when outside, especially at dawn and dusk.**
- **Never leave cats or dogs outside after dark.**
- **Don’t leave food or water outside for pets.**
- **If you must leave your pet outside, secure it in a fully enclosed kennel.**
- **Keep your pets up to date on vaccinations.**
