



McIntyre Street Improvement Project

West 56th Place to West 58th Avenue

W. 56th Place at McIntyre Street full closure planned

W. 56th Place will be closed at McIntyre Street for up to four weeks (24 hours a day) to install storm sewer improvements, place new curb and gutter, and reconstruct the roadway. Direct access to and from McIntyre Street will not be possible during the work. To access properties along W. 56th Place and affected side streets, motorists will need to enter the neighborhood through the W. 54th Avenue / Pike Street intersection. Refer to the detour map on the back of this flier for more information.

This closure is scheduled to begin on or after October 17 once Xcel Energy completes gas line relocation work in the same area. As the closure date approaches, message boards along the corridor will display the latest schedule information. Project updates are also available on the website (<https://www.jeffco.us/2850/Public-Improvement-Projects>) and hotline (720-550-9695). All work is weather-dependent and subject to change.

Work continues on the McIntyre Street bridge over Van Bibber Creek

Jefferson County and SEMA Construction have made significant progress constructing the new bridge over Van Bibber Creek. Crews are currently working adjacent to the west side of McIntyre Street forming and pouring concrete bridge abutments and piers.

Since July, crews have constructed storm sewer and water line improvements along both sides of the road where possible. Xcel Energy is currently resolving additional gas line conflicts so storm sewer construction can continue.

Motorists should continue to expect intermittent traffic stops and alternating lane closures between 8:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m., Monday - Friday. Occasional night and weekend work is expected. The speed limit is reduced to 25 mph with fines doubled in the construction zone. Speed enforcement is being conducted by the Jefferson County Sheriff's Office.
