



Trail Stewardship Team Frequently Asked Questions

Q. What kind of work will do we complete?

A. We will be doing a variety of trail maintenance at our parks, which involves digging and moving dirt as well as moving and breaking rocks to ensure proper drainage when it rains or snows.

Q. What does an average day look like?

A. An average day looks like this:

8:00AM – 8:15AM	Meet crew leader and ensure all team members are present and ready to go Load onto busses
8:15AM – 8:45AM	Drive to park
8:45AM – 9:15AM	Get tools for the day and hike to work location
9:15AM – 10:00AM	Work on trails
10:00AM – 10:15AM	Morning Break
10:15AM – 12:00PM	Work on trails
12:00PM – 12:30PM	Lunch
12:30PM – 2:00PM	Work on trails
2:00PM – 2:15PM	Afternoon Break
2:15PM – 3:30PM	Work on trails
3:30PM – 4:00PM	Hike back to busses and load tools
4:00PM – 4:30PM	Drive back to Open Space parking lot
4:30PM	Dismissed for day

Q. When will I know if I have been hired or not?

A. All candidates will be contacted via email by May 8th, 2020

Q. When is the first day of work?

A. 1) A mandatory orientation for selected Crew Member Orientation is the first *evening* of work.

- **June 9, 2020**, 6:30 pm – 8:00 pm, at the Jefferson County Fairgrounds.

A. 2) Regularly scheduled work days begin on **June 16, 2020** and end on **July 30, 2020**.

- Work days: Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday
- Work hours: 8:00 am – 4:30 pm

Q. Where do I report for work?

- A. We meet in the Open Space parking lot every day at 8:00 a.m.
- Everyone is expected to be on time and have all their personal equipment.
 - We will travel to the work site at approximately 8:00 a.m. and leave the work site at 4:00 p.m., arriving back in the Open Space parking lot at approximately 4:30 p.m.
 - If you miss the bus in the morning, you will not be able to work and, as a result, will not be paid for that day.
 - Everyone will be transported by the TST bus only. No personal vehicles will be taken to the work sites.

Q. What will I need to wear and bring with me every day?

- A. Open Space will supply you with three TST t-shirts, a hard hat, and a pair of gloves. A list of required and suggested items is on the website

Q. What crew will I be in?

- A. Crews are assigned randomly, you will meet your crew and crew leader at orientation on June 9th.

Q. What if I can't make it to work?

- A. If you are sick or cannot come in you are asked to call the Trail Stewardship Team Hotline, (303) 271-5965, as soon as possible to report your absence.
- Crew Members may miss no more than 2 days, except for verified medical reasons or family emergencies.

Q. How much will I be paid and how often?

- A. \$12.00 an hour. Paychecks will be distributed every other week.
