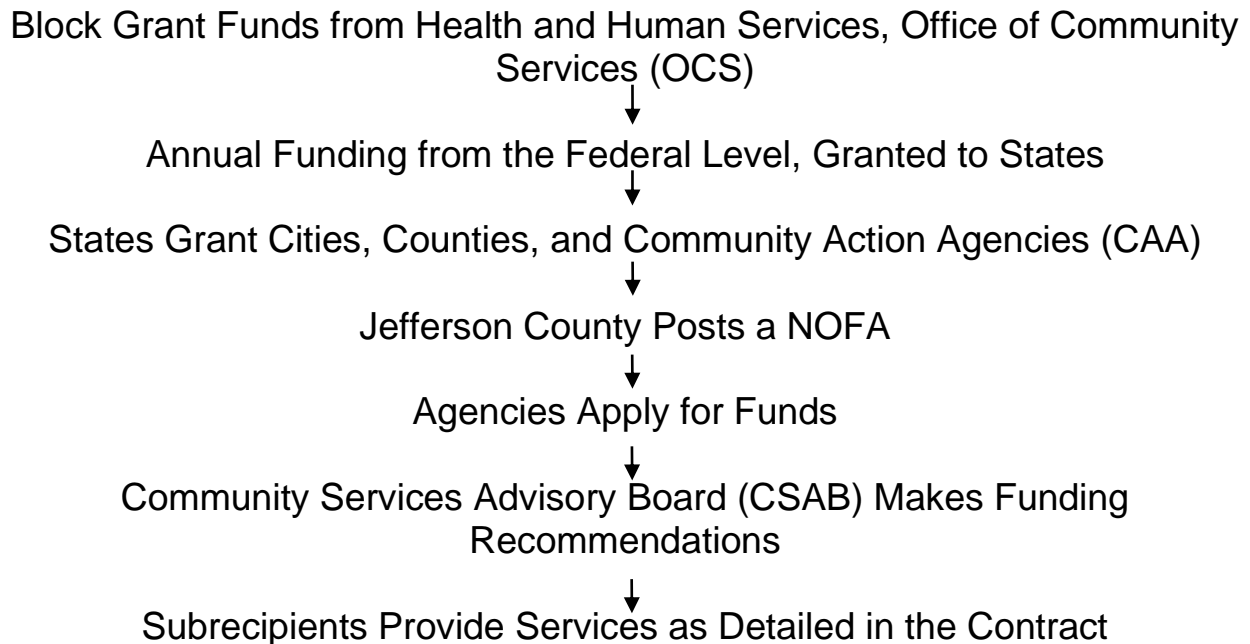


Community Services Block Grant

The **Community Services Block Grant (CSBG)** is a federally funded program that provides formulaic grants to alleviate the causes and conditions of poverty in communities.



CSBG funding supports projects that;

- Lessen poverty in communities,
- Address the needs of low-income individuals including the homeless, migrants and the elderly,
- Provide services and activities addressing employment, education, income management, housing, emergency services, nutrition, linkages with other programs, self-sufficiency and health.

With the support of CSBG funding, states and CAAs work together to achieve the following goals for low-income individuals:

- Increased self-sufficiency,
- Improved living conditions,
- Ownership of and pride in their communities,
- Strong family and support systems.
