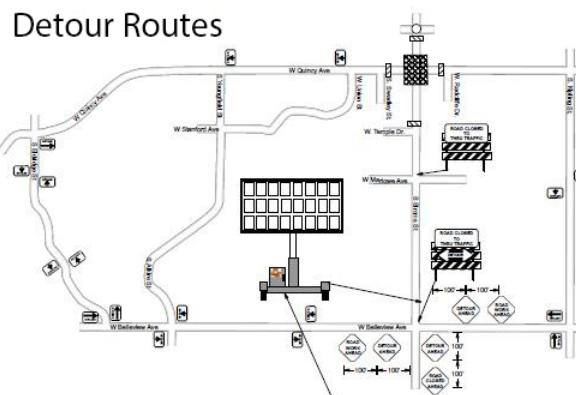
Final Paving Monday, November 25, 2019 Quincy/Simms Intersection Closed from 8:30 am – Until completion

JEFFERSON COUNTY, COLO – American Civil Constructors (ACC) will be performing the final lift of pavement on Monday, November 25, 2019 which will prompt a full closure of the Quincy and Simms intersection from 8:30 a.m. until paving is complete.

This closure will be the final full closure for Phase I, but drivers should still expect minor traffic holds through November as crews finalize striping and signage. There will be no work activities from Thursday – Sunday in observance of Thanksgiving.

RECOMMENDED DETOURS:

- ACC cannot place signage on US 285 or close the off-ramps even though through traffic on Simms will be prohibited on November 25, 2019. Drivers should access Quincy from Kipling or E-470.
- Travelers wanting to head north/south from Quincy to West Belleview should use S. Alkire/S Youngsfield. Detour signage will be posted at S. Simms and Belleview redirecting through traffic.
- West Quincy Place and West Radcliffe Driver are privately owned streets and should not be used as a detour.
- ACC will assure that busses and emergency vehicles can travel through the Simms/Quincy intersection during this construction phase.



TRAFFIC IMPACTS:

- Monday November 25, 2019 – full closure of the intersection at Quincy & Simms from 8:30 – until the completion of paving operations.

- During regular operations ACC may have minor traffic holds in order to perform striping and signage work.
- There will be no work activities Thursday November 28, 2019 – December 1, 2019.

The improvements to West Quincy Avenue (Simms to Tufts) will be addressed in three phases with three separate contracts extending into 2024. Phase I, ACC's contract, is scheduled for completion this fall and involves the reconstruction of the round-about at Simms to South Swadley Court.
