### AUTHORIZATION FOR CRIMINAL BACKGROUND CHECK

Colorado Election Law and the Secretary of State Rules require the County Clerks to conduct an Internet Criminal History Check from the Colorado Bureau of Investigation for all employees who staff the counting center and who work in certain areas during elections. The purpose of the check is to determine whether the employee has been found guilty of a crime involving breach of trust, fraudulent, coercive, or dishonest practices or demonstrating incompetence, untrustworthiness, or other election offense. The law and rules prohibit an employee who has been found guilty of any of these crimes from working on certain election-related activities.

The Jefferson County Clerk and Recorder requests that you authorize an Internet Criminal History Check from the Colorado Bureau of Investigation by signing on the space provided below.
