

Inmates sentenced to county jail may receive deductions off his or her sentence for a variety of reasons, including:

- *Active involvement with the Behavioral Health Unit or Veterans Unit
- *Active involvement with our Trusty or Alternative Sentencing Program
- *Assisting in an extraordinary manner

These deductions are commonly known as “good time” and how much good time earned varies depending on how it is earned. For inmates released through the early release program, good time has been calculated into the percentage of their time served.
