WHEREAS, we are dedicated to help victims of domestic violence by providing advocacy, education, services, and resources; and

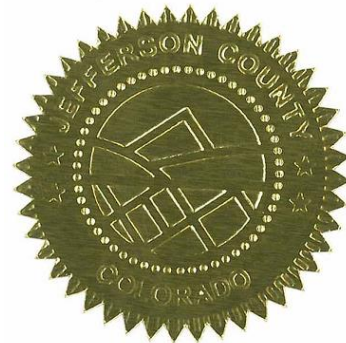
WHEREAS, Jefferson County encourages members of the community to work together to increase domestic violence awareness.
