Instructions:

- A tastings permit may be issued only to licensed retail liquor stores and liquor licensed drug stores. Fill in you County and State license numbers in the blanks above. If you do not have one of these license types, you may complete DR8404 Retail License Application for a Retail Liquor Store or Liquor Licensed Drug Store to apply for one
- 2. This application must be submitted with the items listed below to be considered complete:

Proof of server training program completion

Copies of the front and back of the server training program certification cards

Tastings schedule

Diagram of location with serving areas outlined

Fees as listed above

A complete application must be submitted at least 15 days before the scheduled Liquor Licensing Authority hearing. The hearing must be before your scheduled tastings

- 3. Provide with this application copies of the front and back of the server training program certification cards for all persons conducting the tastings, in order to show they have completed a server training program that meets the standards established by the State Liquor Enforcement Division.
- 4. Provide with this application a schedule of the dates and times all tastings will be held, using a monthly calendar with the tasting times listed on each specific day. Pursuant to C.R.S § 44-3-301 (10), tastings shall not exceed a total of five hours

in duration per day, shall be conducted no earlier than 11 a.m. or later then 7 p.m., and may occur no more than four of the six days from a Monday to the following Saturday for a total of 156 days per year. No Sunday tastings are allowed.

- 5. Provide with this application an 8 ½" by 11" diagram of the licensed premises with the tastings area outlined.
- 6. After application review, you may be asked to submit other information to satisfy the Authority that the desired tastings will be conducted in compliance with state and local laws and will not create a public safety risk to the neighborhood.
- 7. You will not be issued a tasting permit if your liquor license for the subject premises has been suspended or revoked, or you have had a suspension held in abeyance or stayed by payment within the last year.

- 4. I declare under penalty of perjury in the second degree that this application and all attachments are true, correct, and complete to the best of my knowledge. I understand that my establishment must adhere to the following in conducting our tastings:
 - a. The alcohol beverage used in tastings must be purchased through a licensed wholesaler, licensed brew pub, licensed distillery pub, or licensed winery at a cost that is not less than the laid-in cost of the alcohol beverage.
 - b. The size of an individual alcohol sample must not exceed one ounce of malt or vinous liquor or one-half of one ounce of spiritous liquor.
 - c. Patron must be prohibited from leaving the licensed premises with an unconsumed sample.
 - d. All open and unconsumed alcohol beverage samples must be removed from the licensed premises or the samples destroyed immediately following the completion of the tasting.
 - e. My establishment must not serve a person who is under twenty-one years of age or who is visibly intoxicated.
 - f. My establishment must not serve more than four individual samples to a patron during tasting.
 - g. Alcohol samples will be in open containers and provided to a patron free of charge.

I certify that my liquor license for the subject premises has not been suspended or revoked, nor has a suspension been held in abeyance or stayed by payment within the last year. I acknowledge that it is my responsibility and the responsibility of my agents and employees to comply with all Jefferson County Polices and Procedures and the Colorado State Liquor Code.
