Scope and Content Note	

A collection of postcards gathered from numerous accessions into one box. All are numbered with their original accession number identifying donor and related collection.

Images represent Denver Mountain Parks: The Lariat Loop, Lookout Mountain and Buffalo Bill's Grave, and Park of the Red Rocks; Mt. Evans; Tiny Town; Bear Creek Canon; Clear Creek Canon; Denver City buildings; Lutheran Sanatorium; the Colorado School of Mines emblem above Golden; Jefferson County Courthouse; Sinclair dinosaur exhibit at the 1933 World's Fair; and miscellaneous mountain roads.

The majority of the color postcards are standard 3½ x 5½ inches of various eras (linen, white border, early divided back). There are, however, 18 miniature cards with black and white images measuring 2½ x 3¾ inches, and one jumbo souvenir card of the Georgetown Loop.
