

RMMA Advisory Board – Regular Meeting

April 14, 2021 Minutes

1. Call to Order: The meeting was called to order at 5:00pm.

3. Approval of Minutes – March 10th minutes were approved as written.

4. Public Comment

Andrew Walker, resident of Superior – Discussed his upcoming Eagle Scout project painting the segmented circle at RMMA.

Elizabeth Heidl, resident of Skyestone – Discussed airport noise and theories for the rise in noise complaints. In addition, she referenced aviation easements as a tool to protect the airport from lawsuits from residents who purchase homes within the airport influence area.

Emily Hogan, assistant city manager of Louisville – Mentioned that noise complaints may not paint a complete picture of the noise issues, as local governments receive a substantial number of noise complaints from numerous households.

5. Business Items

A. RMMA Data on Noise Complaints and Surrounding Context – Paul Anslow, RMMA Director

The airport provided various statistics and considerations related to airport noise complaints in order to put some of the public comments in context, including considerations related to:

- Household growth,
- Operational growth,

- Noise complaints per household,
- Social media campaigning,
- Property values, and
- Airport/Jeffco warnings over encroaching residential growth.

Paul Anslow also gave some additional context around airport planning as it relates to the advisory board's recent work. Joe Ramos also provided some comments as it relates to potential airport impacts on public health.

B. Community Engagement/Outreach As

Phil Rosnik noted that there should be additional opportunities for the Airport Advisory Board to engage with other airport stakeholders, especially as the public health measures for COVID-19 improve. For example, the Board of County Commissioners suggested engagement with the recently formed RMMA Community Noise Roundtable. The board will be looking for additional participation as we begin to engage other groups.
