

Job Description Warehouse Worker

About the Role:

TheWarehouse Worker will build connections with households who are food insecure. The position consists primarily of loading delivery vehicles and working in the warehouse for any task that needs completion such as picking/packing boxes, organizing, cleaning, shipping/receiving and re-packaging as needed. This position will develop strong relationships with local food pantries and food suppliers.

Requirements:

- Positive attitude and self-motivation critical
- Ability to lift 60lb. regularly and safely
- Delivery driving and customer service experience preferred.
- Vehicle in good operating condition mileage reimbursed

- Demonstrated experience working with diverse populations
- Basic Computer skills and program proficiency

Position Type/ Work Schedule: This is a part or full-time, hourly position, requiring occasional evening and weekend work and the ability to be flexible and responsive to emergent needs of Benefits in Action.
