



NOTICE OF FUNDING AVAILABILITY
JEFFERSON COUNTY COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT
2021 Community Development Block Grant CARES (CDBG-CV) Act Program

Jefferson County received a funding allocation from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) through the Community Development Block Grant CARES (CDBG-CV) Act. These funds are to be used to help communities prevent, prepare for, and respond to coronavirus.

Jefferson County has elected to focus its CDBG-CV Round 3 funds on programs that provide direct services primarily to persons experiencing homelessness, actively connect persons experiencing homelessness with housing and providing homelessness services for individuals and families, with a focus on the following activities:

- Street outreach services
- Emergency subsistence payments to prevent homelessness and maintain housing
- Targeted services for persons experiencing homelessness including, but not limited to access to food, shelter, transportation, mobile operations/options
- Agency staffing to provide services and administer CDBG eligible program

Jefferson County is requesting **Intent to Apply** letters from eligible entities, which include non-profit organizations, and government and quasi-governmental agencies serving low- and moderate-income Jefferson County residents. Letters must follow the format listed below:

1. Provide a 1000 or fewer word abstract that describes your project proposal meeting the objective noted above,
2. Describe the need/problem and provide data/factual evidence,
3. Describe the agencies experience providing such services,
4. Describe the agencies staffing or need of additional staffing to provide such services,
5. Describe your targeted population including such things as age, gender, ethnicity, geographic area, etc.,
6. Include a project timeline,
7. Include the cost of the project or program and how funding would help with the identified problem.

Preference will be given to projects or programs focusing on providing direct services to persons experiencing homelessness, actively connect persons experiencing homelessness with housing and providing services for individuals and families currently experiencing homelessness. Collaborative initiatives are encouraged to support continued stability, such as counseling and case management, food assistance, employment services, skill development, financial coaching, clothing, medical assistance, etc.

Intent to Apply letters will be reviewed and if deemed eligible, agencies will be invited to complete a full application. Letters must be submitted via email no later than **Monday, January 17, 2021, 5:00 p.m.** to Cheryl-Kaye Barker at ckbarker@jeffco.us.
