

Summary of Regulation Changes – Adopted 9/27/11

Zoning Resolution

Section 1 Administrative Provisions	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Minor changes to the submittal requirement waiver provisions.• Removed the requirement to submit a mylar from the regulation so that the small size ODP documents and Special Use Documents can be recorded on paper. The mylar will still be required for a 24 x 36 inch format.• Revised the description of an ODP to focus the emphasis on the written restrictions of the document and to indicate that a graphic depiction of the property <u>may</u> be required if it is necessary to portray the configuration of use areas and other features.• Revised the description of a Special Use Document to focus the emphasis on the written restrictions of the document and to indicate that a graphic depiction of the property <u>may</u> be required if it is necessary to portray the configuration of use areas and other features.• Replaced the term “mylar” with “final documents” so that it is clear that a mylar is not required with every application.
