Purpose: To control of fugitive dust emissions caused by the sanding and sweeping of County roads and streets to the extent reasonably practical without sacrificing the public's safety or welfare.

Policy: Control of Fugitive Dust Emissions from Street Sanding

A. Compliance with State Regulations

1. Jefferson County has environmental concerns over the fugitive dust emissions from excessive street and road sanding and is committed to reducing emissions of PM-10 and PM-2.5.
2. The Road and Bridge Division is instructed to take appropriate action to control fugitive dust emissions from the sanding of streets and roads within Jefferson County in accordance with the Department of Public Health and Environment's Air Quality Care Commission's Regulation 16, "Street Sanding Emissions".

B. Regulations

1. The Road and Bridge Director shall at all times be authorized to sand streets at any location and in such quantities as determined to be reasonably necessary for the protection of the public's safety and welfare. When deemed appropriate by the Road and Bridge Director, he/she shall respond to requests for additional sand from public safety officials and agencies.
2. The Road and Bridge Director shall ensure that the County's use of street and sanding materials complies with or exceeds the Air Quality Care Commission's standards, including those standards provided for material types, testing, record keeping and reporting.
3. All equipment used in street and road sanding and sweeping shall be inspected and maintained so as to prevent excessive use of sanding materials.
4. The Road and Bridge Division shall conduct training and educational program for the operators of street sanding equipment to: teach operational best practices that reduce excess application of sanding material.
