Purpose: To establish reasonable fees and exceptions from fees for a Dog License.

A. Introduction

1. The Board of County Commissioners has previously adopted an Animal Control Regulation by Ordinance. This policy sets the fees to be charged for licensing of dogs pursuant to the Animal Control Regulation.
2. All terms contained herein are defined in the Animal Control Regulation.

B. Fees

The Dog Owner shall pay a Licensing fee of \$20.00 for any dog, spayed/neutered or unaltered.

C. Exceptions

1. Owners of service dogs (as defined in State and Federal Statutes) will be exempt from the annual License fee as to the extent provided by State and Federal legislation.
2. Licensed Facility owners as defined in the Animal Control Regulation shall be exempt from the License fee provided they submit proof of licensing by the United States Department of Agriculture or the Colorado Department of Agriculture. Licensed Facility owners shall be subject to all other licensing provisions, as set forth in this policy and the Animal Control Regulation.
