

## **WEST QUINCY AVENUE (W. TUFTS AVE. TO S. SIMMS ST.) QUICK FACTS**

- Funded by Jefferson County 2001 Sales Tax Improvement Program and by Impact Fees
- Quincy Ave. is being reclassified from a Minor Arterial to a Major Collector which will help achieve the following:
  - Traffic calming
  - Discourage truck traffic
  - More pedestrian friendly
- West of S. Arbutus Way, Quincy Ave. 2 layout options:
  - Alternate A: 4 (11' wide) thru lanes with and a center median
  - Alternate B: 2 (11' wide) thru lanes with left dedicated left turn lanes, enhanced center medians, and landscaped pedestrian zone
- East of S. Arbutus Way, Quincy Ave. will be 2 (11' wide) thru lanes with a painted 12' wide two-way left-turn lane in the center.
- A new roundabout will be constructed at the intersection S. Union St. and Quincy Ave.
- Roundabout improvements at the Quincy/Simms roundabout and future roundabout improvements at the Simms/Nassau roundabout.
- 6' wide attached sidewalk on the north side of Quincy Ave. and 6' wide detached sidewalk on south side of Quincy Ave. from S. Eldridge St. to S. Simms St.
- 4' wide on-street bike lanes from S. Eldridge St. to S. Simms St.
- Construction for the roadway improvements is scheduled from the summer of 2019 to fall of 2020.
- Landscaping is schedule to start in the fall of 2020 after the construction of the roadway improvements is completed.
