

Rules of the Roundabout

Drivers:

- Slow down! The recommended speed for a roundabout is 15 mph.
- Watch for pedestrians.
- Yield to traffic that is already in the roundabout.
- All traffic moves in a counterclockwise motion. Always make a right turn into the roundabout.
- Once inside the roundabout, do not stop. You have the right of way.
- Yield to pedestrians as you exit.
- Miss your exit? Just go around again.
- Do not enter the roundabout when emergency vehicles are approaching. If you are already in the roundabout, proceed to your exit before pulling over.

Bicyclists:

- Use the bicycle / pedestrian paths or follow the same rules as motorists to cycle through the roundabout.

Pedestrians:

- Use the sidewalk.
- Be aware of your surroundings.
- Never walk inside the roundabout or over the center island.
